



















117th Congress & St. Louis District Boundary

Fiscal Year 2021 Delivery

- O&M Financial Summary, over \$112 Million FY21 O&M / MR&T Funding
- Focus is on reducing outyear O&M costs by identifying efficiencies, addressing the highest priorities and reinvesting resources to provide a long-term sustainable program.
 - \$1.6 Million in cost Saving measures
 - \$14 Million for Replacement of Upstream Lift-Gate System at Mel Price Lock and Dam
- Critical Infrastructure Updates
 - Completed Lock 25 Miter Gate Upstream Anchorages
 - Completed Locks 27 Liftgate Hoisting Chains Replacement/Upgrade
 - Completed L25 Bulkhead Crane Installation
 - Award contracts for Mel Price Liftgate Replacement
 - Completed Waterline/Sewer line Replacement at multiple locations
 - Completed Clarence Cannon Dame Excitation/Voltage Regulator replacements

Fiscal Year 2022 Preparation

- Out Year Planning
 - Extensive Planning throughout FY21 left District well positioned for FY22 President's Budget; competing for America Jobs Act funding to further reduce backlog
 - Over \$300 Million in Backlog of Maintenance






MVS Hurricane Response

 requests for assistance.
- MVS employees from across all Divisions are supporting the Roofing Mission.
 - PRT staff deployed downrange to Louisiana and Alabama.
 - Remote QA support from MVS and NWO.
- MVS ECCV-10 is alerted and ready to deploy when called to Louisiana.
- Overall mission is estimated at over 33,600 blue roofs installed.






