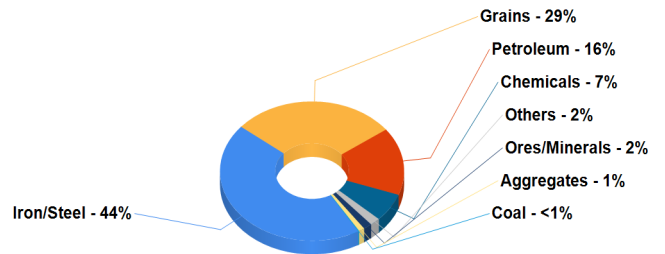

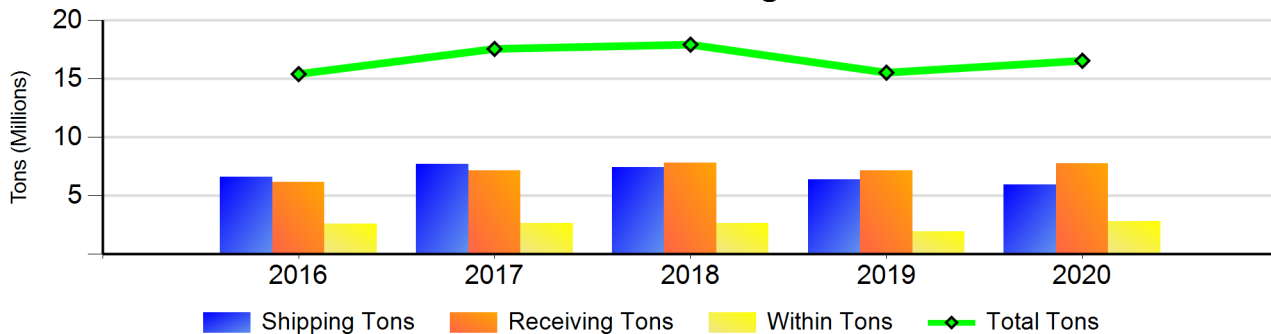
2020 All Traffic Commodity Value Distribution

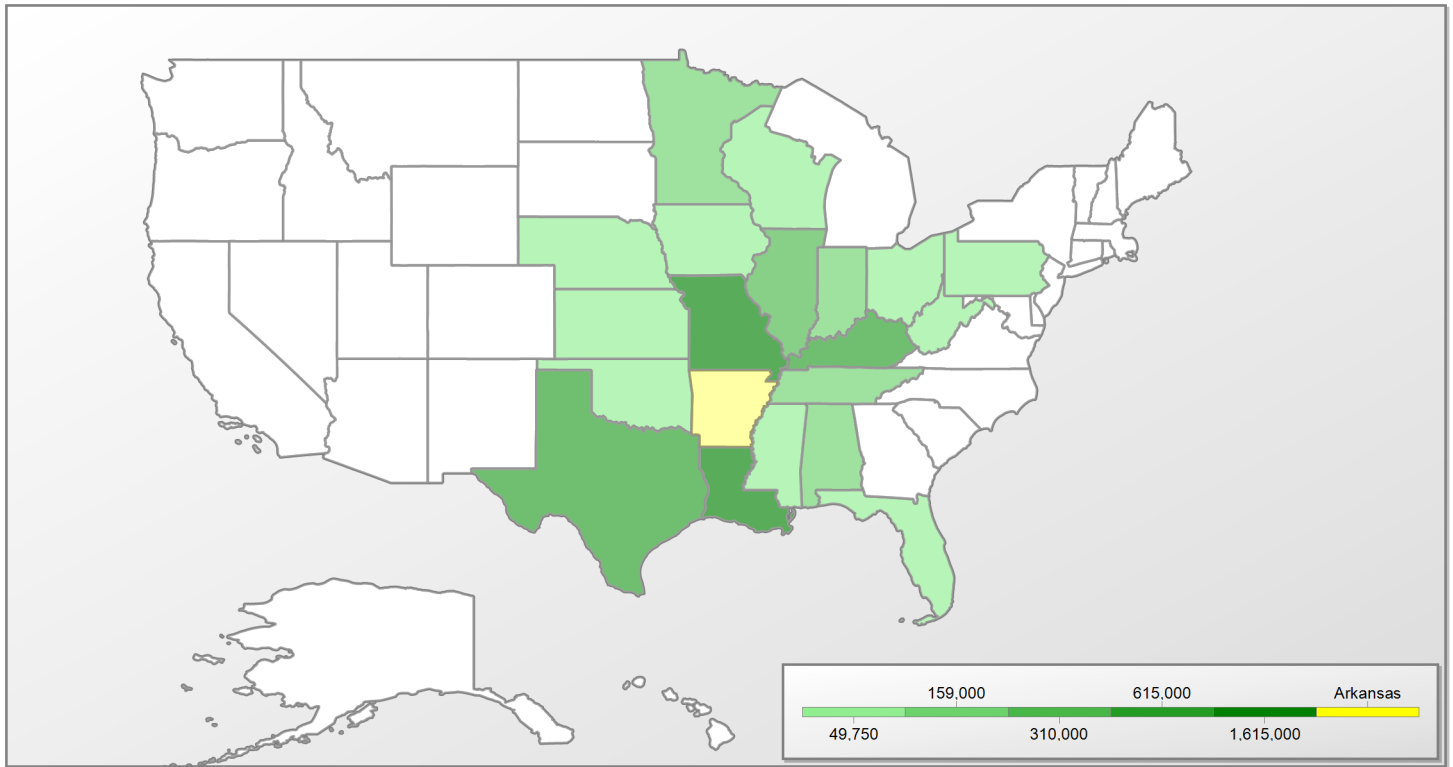

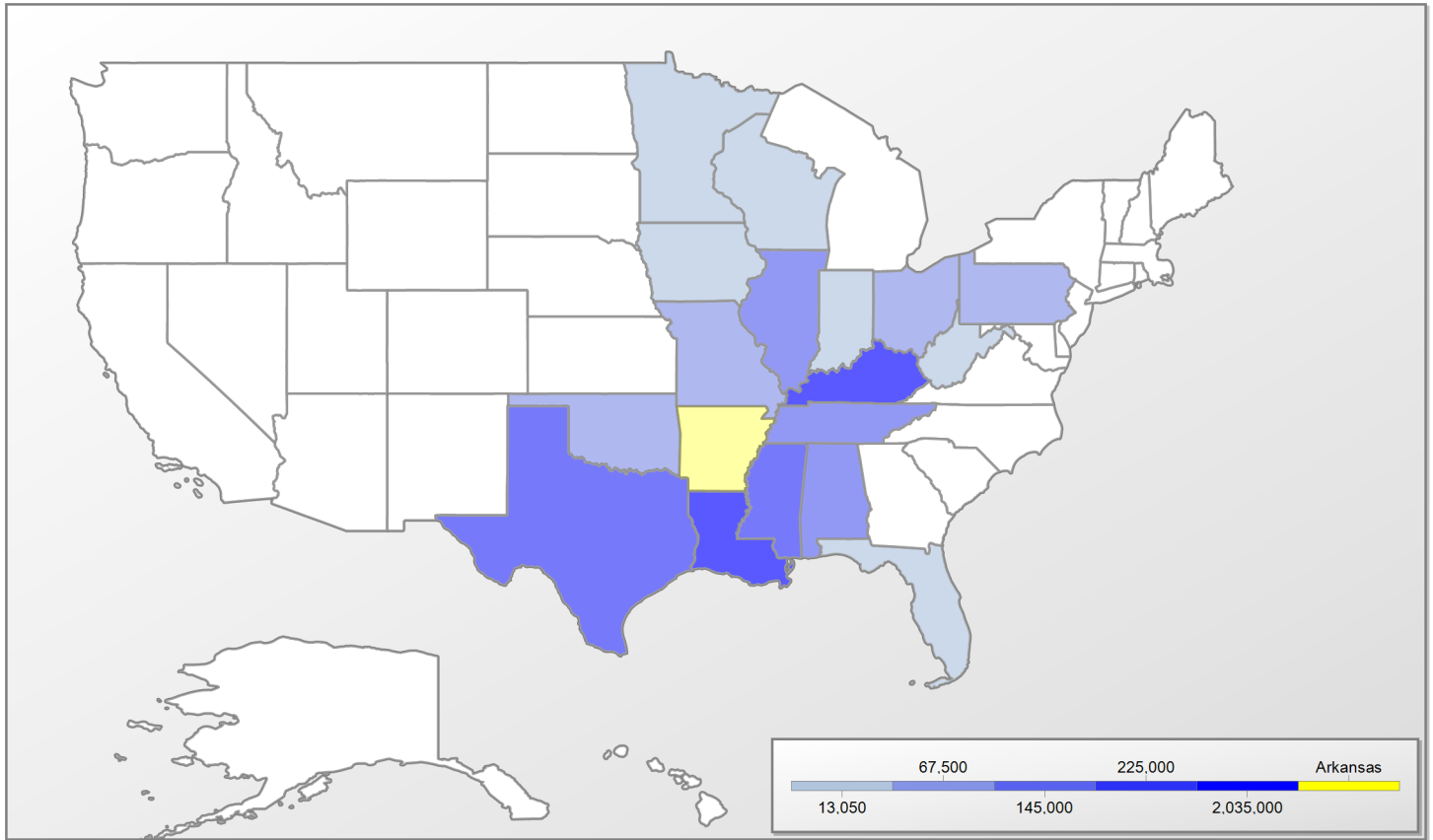

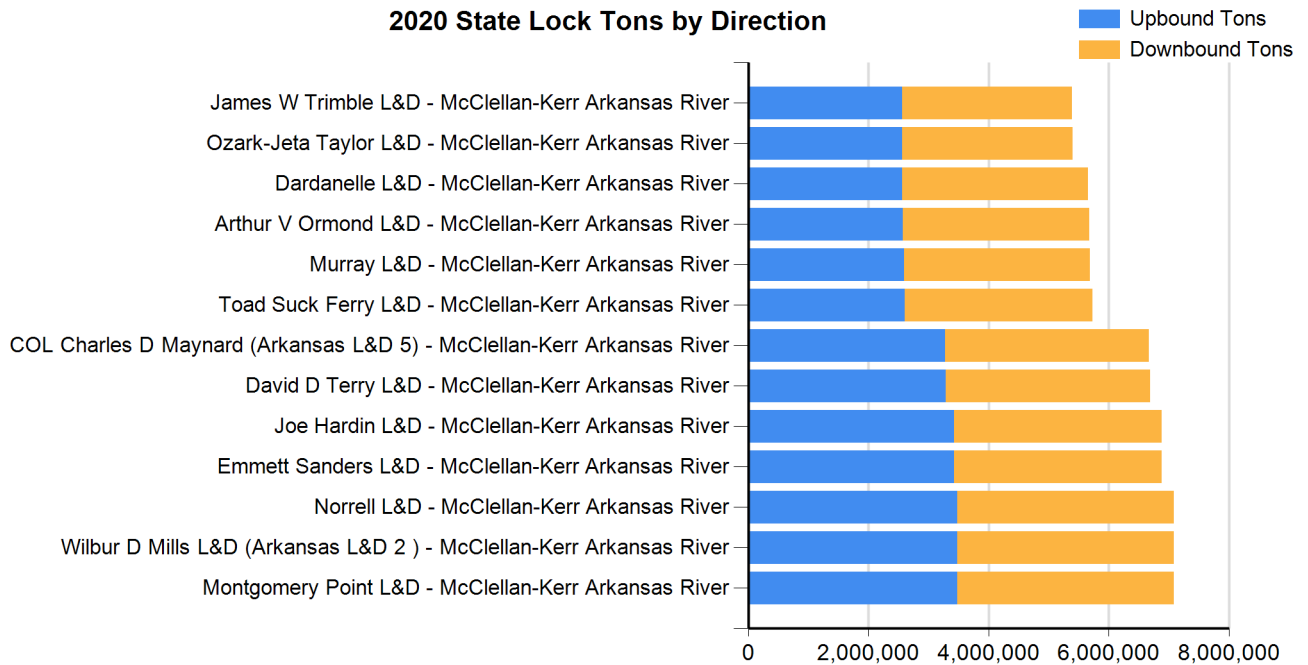

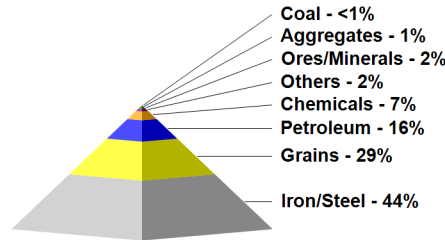
