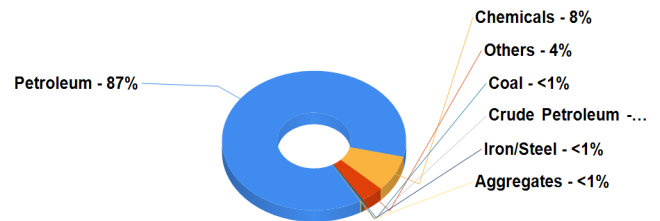

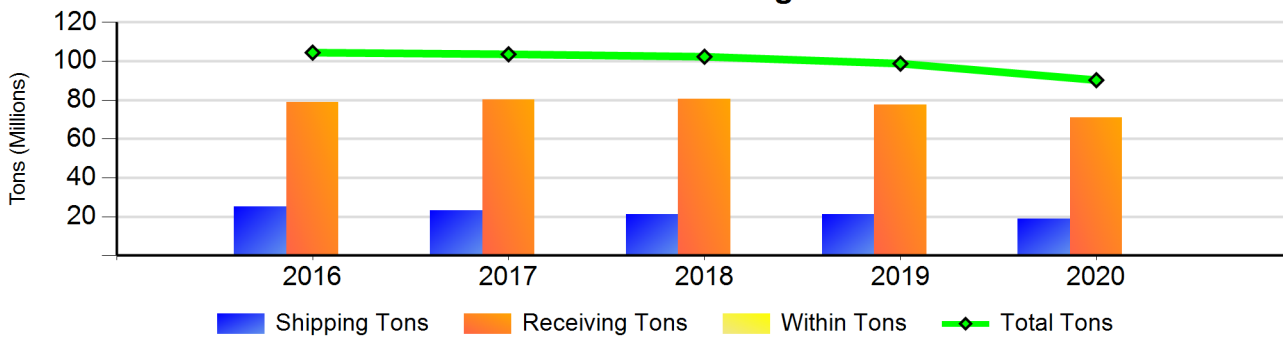
2020 All Traffic Commodity Value Distribution

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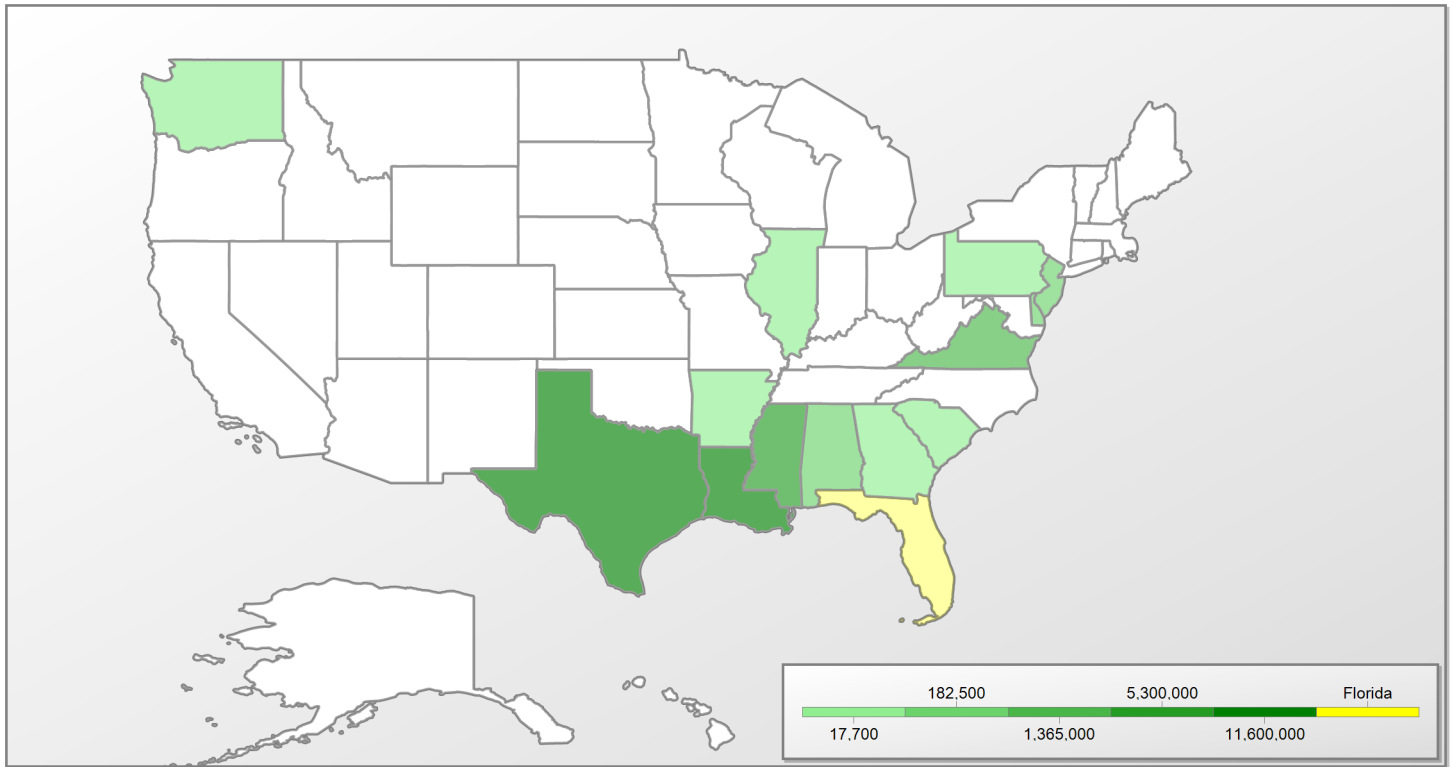

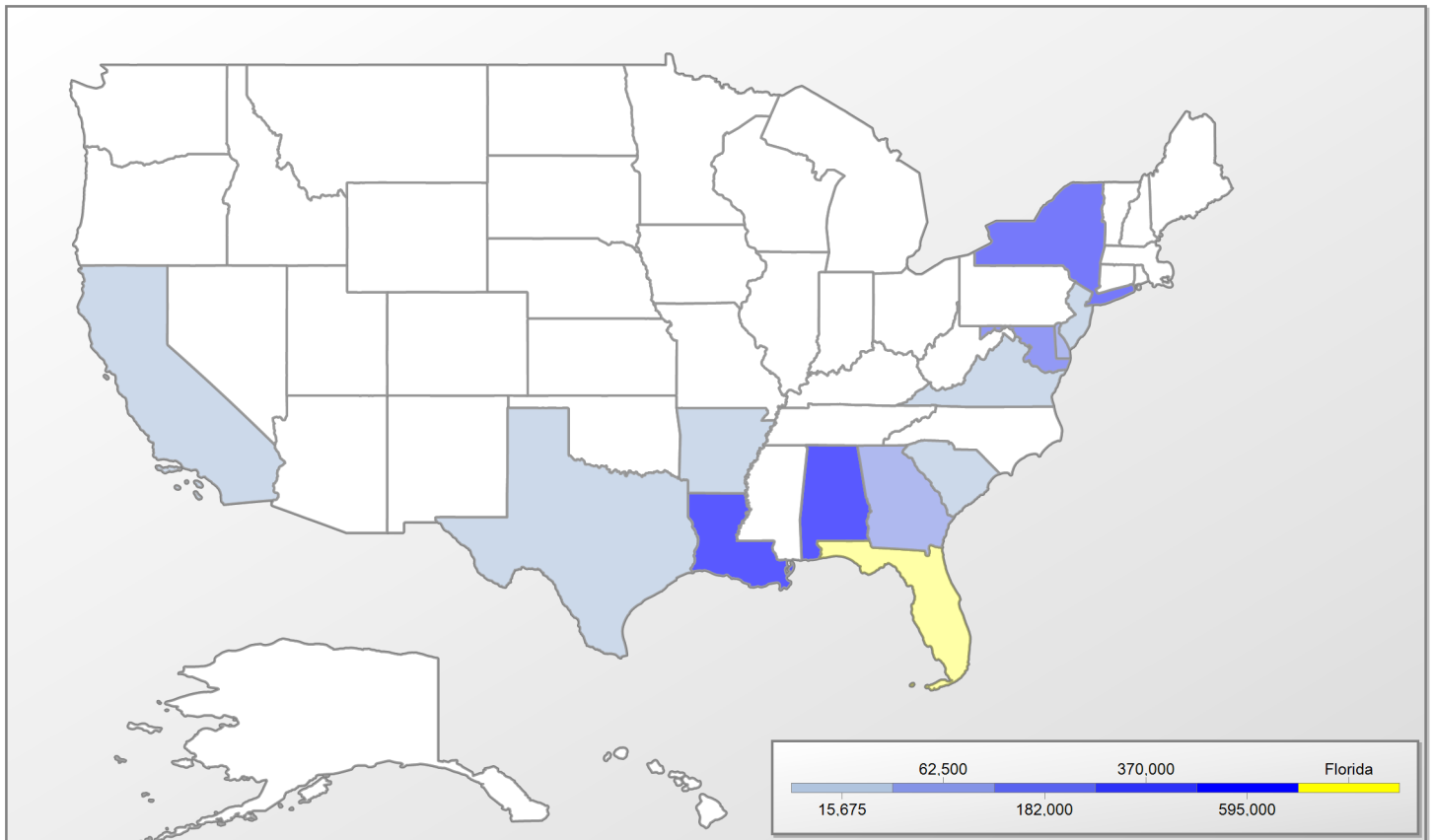

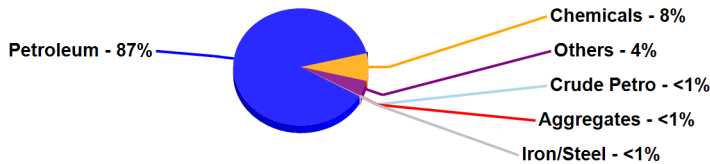

2020 Coastal Traffic Commodity Value Distribution

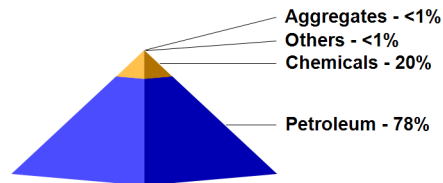
