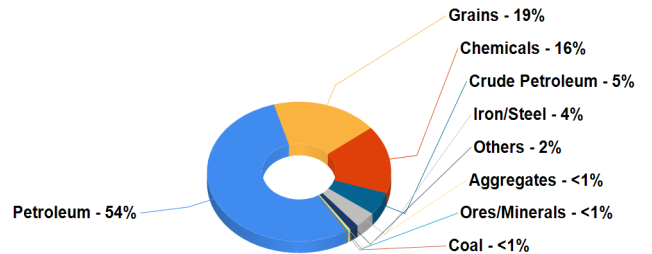

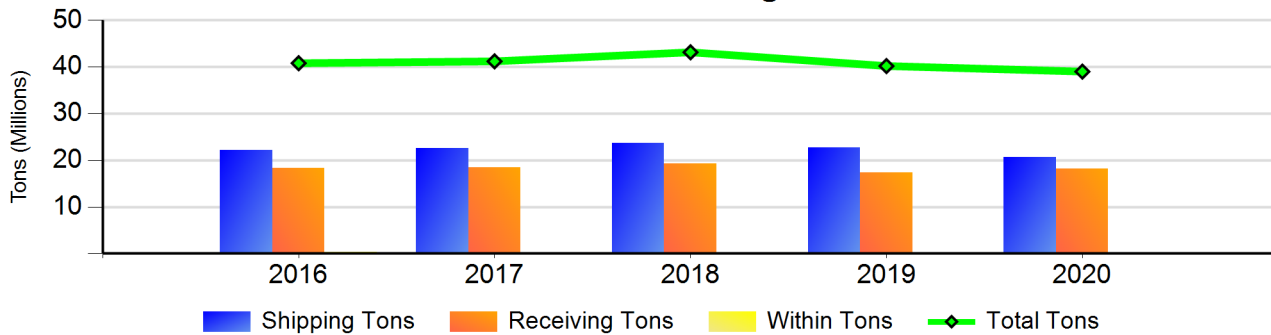

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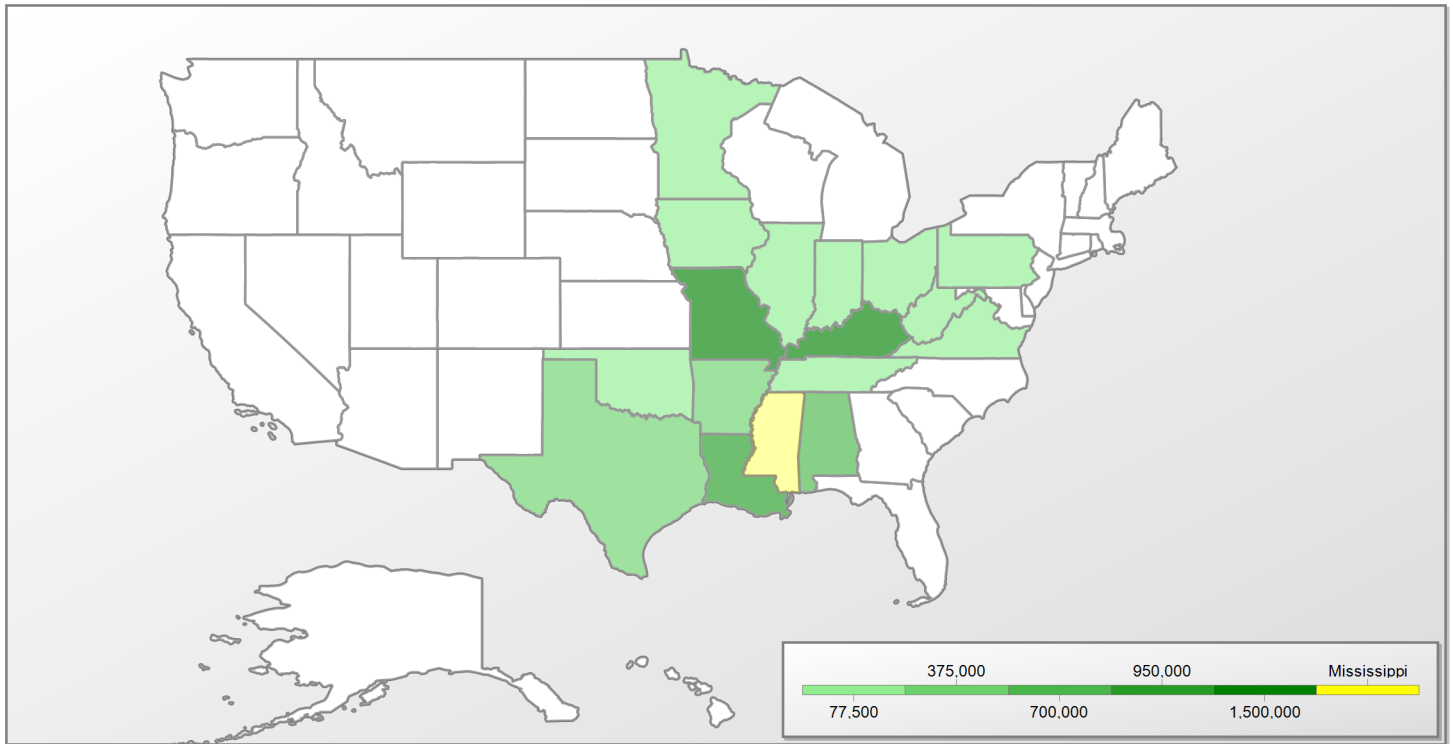

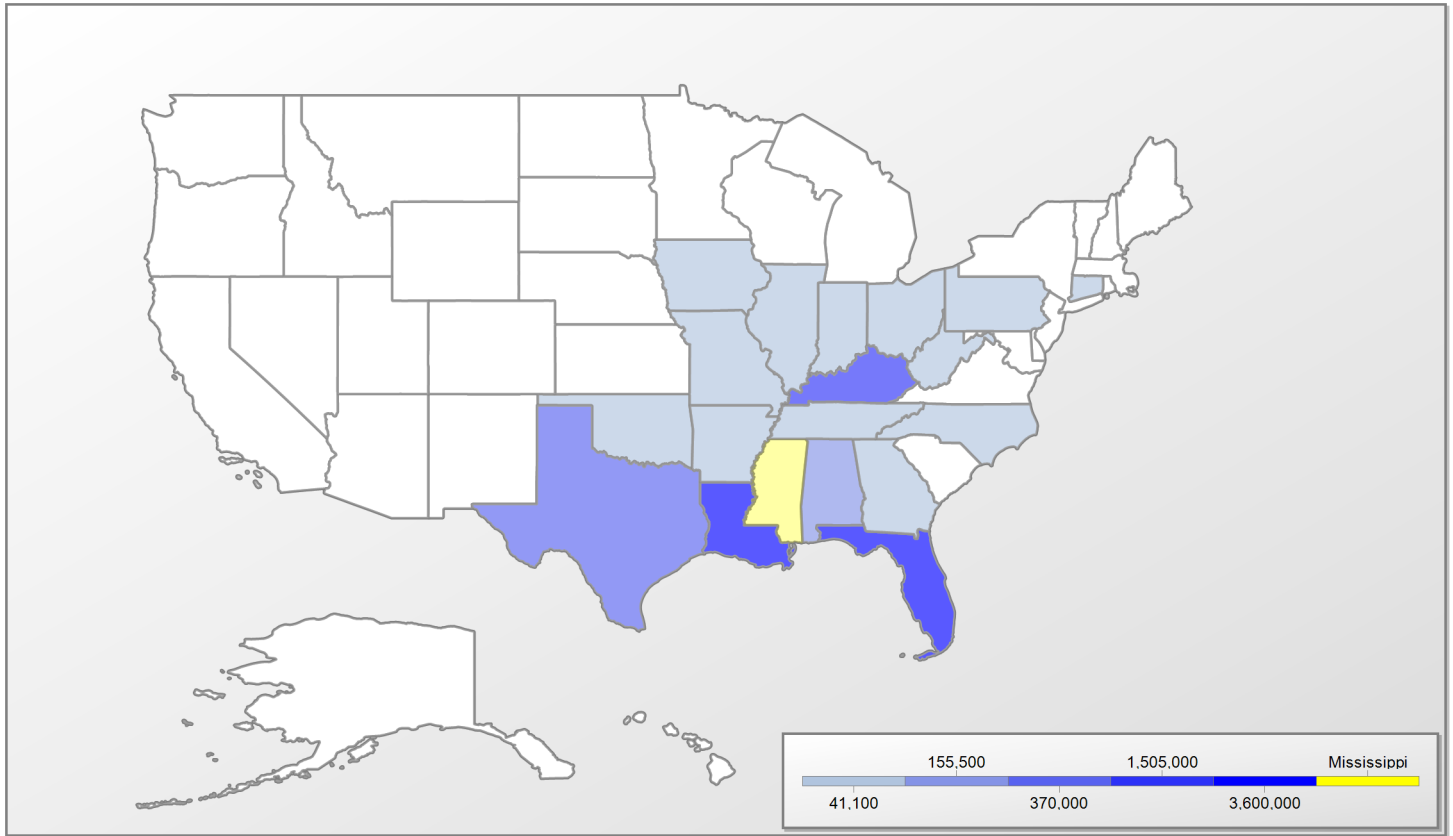

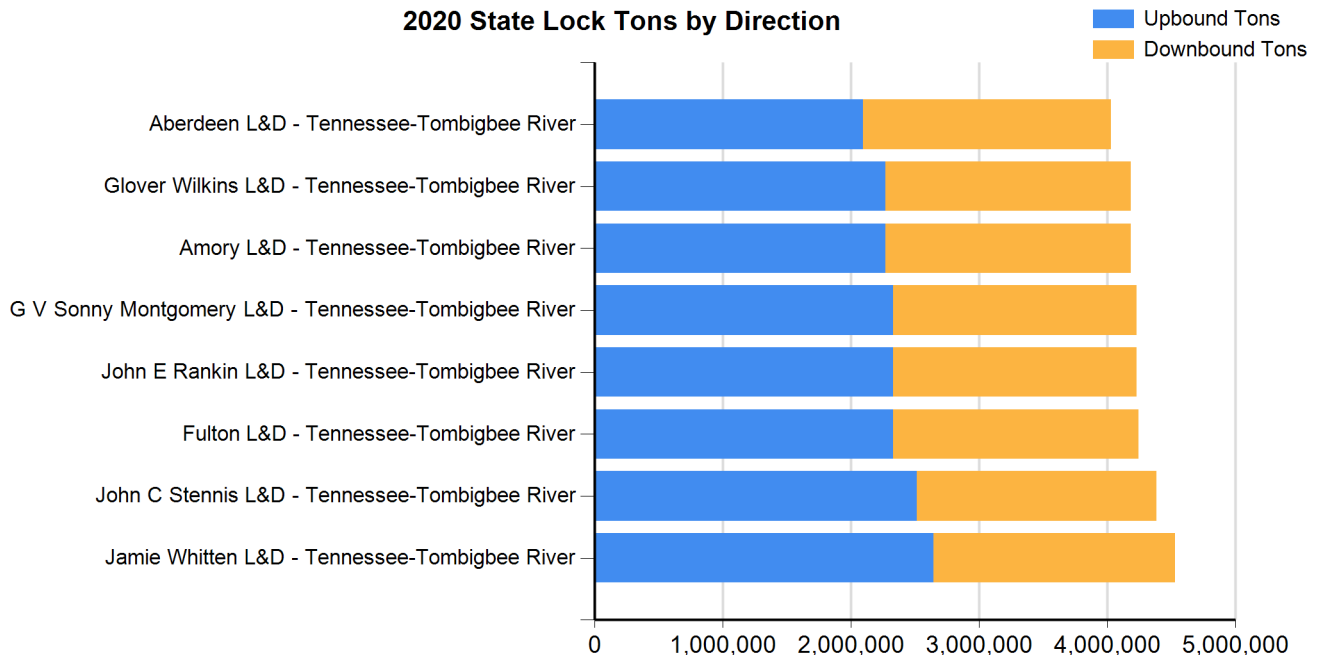

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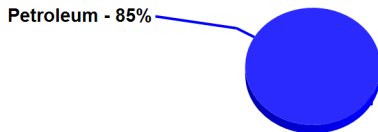

### 2020 Coastal Traffic Commodity Value Distribution

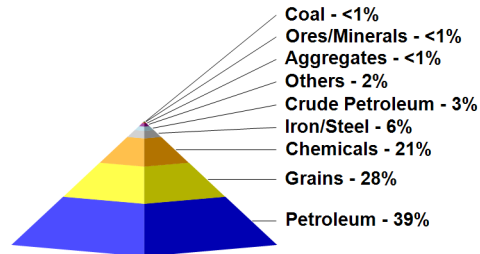
Total Value: \$2.16 (Billion)
