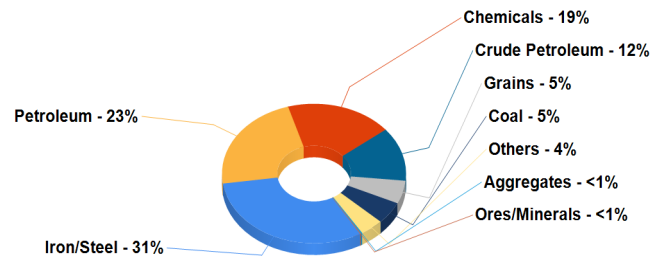

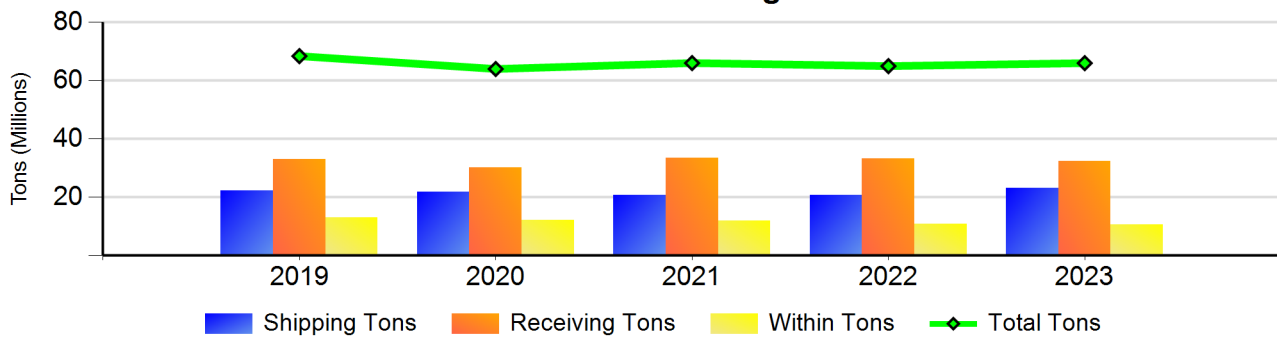
2023 All Traffic Commodity Value Distribution

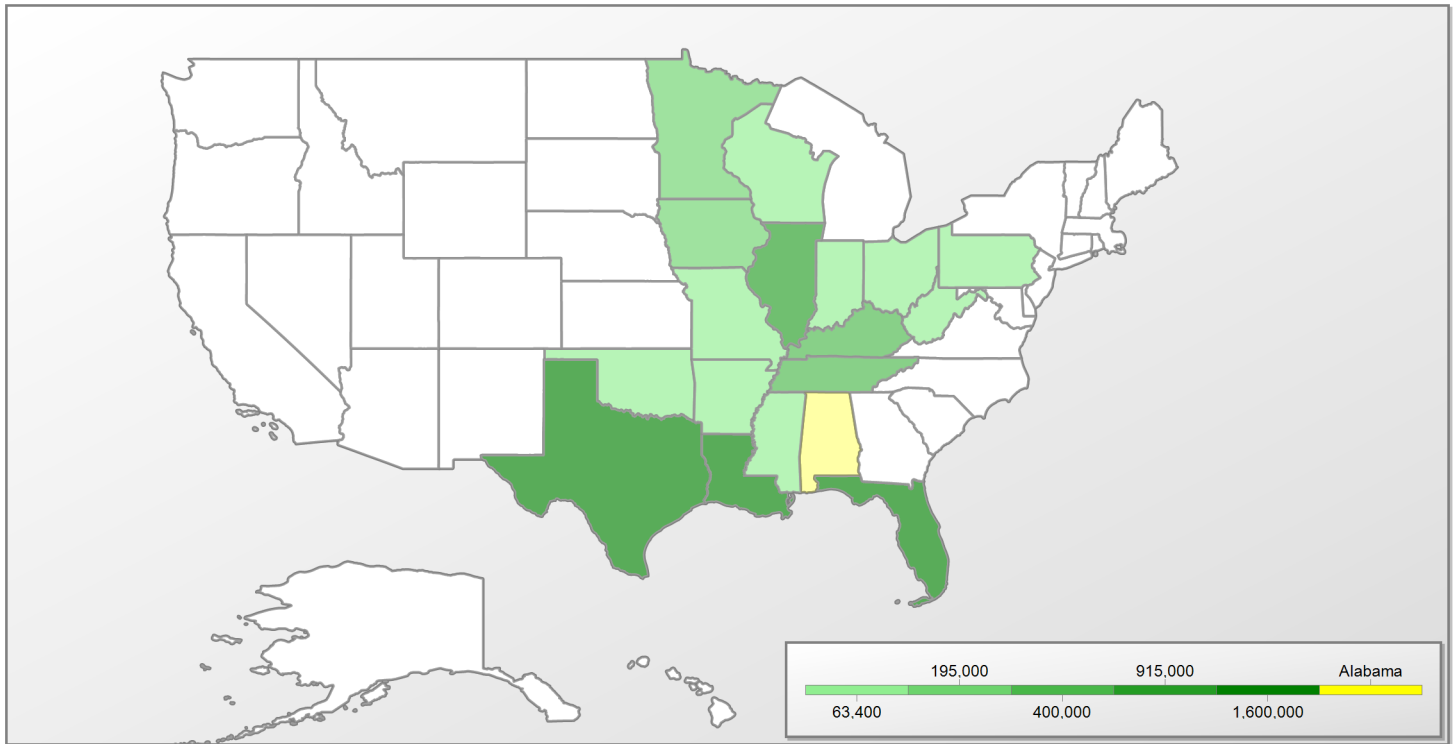

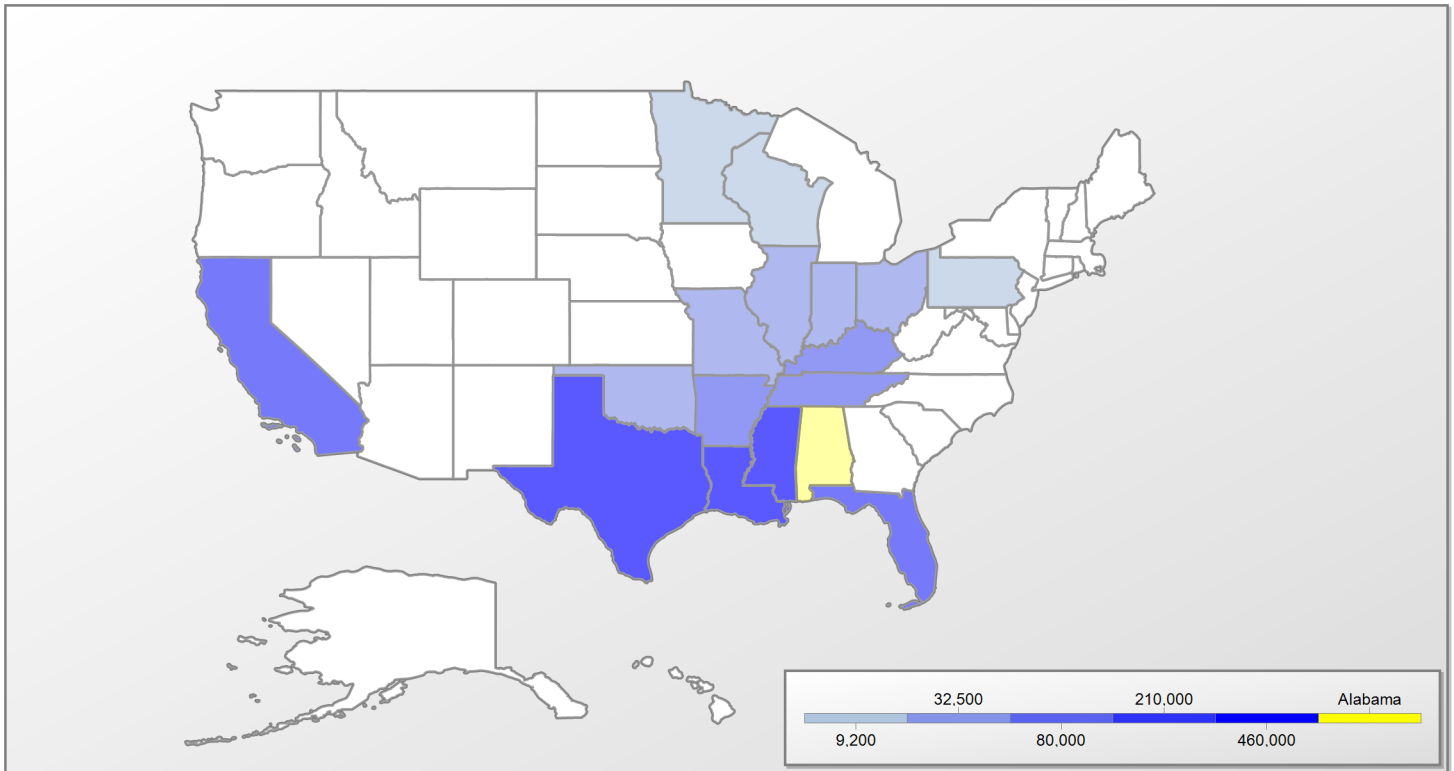

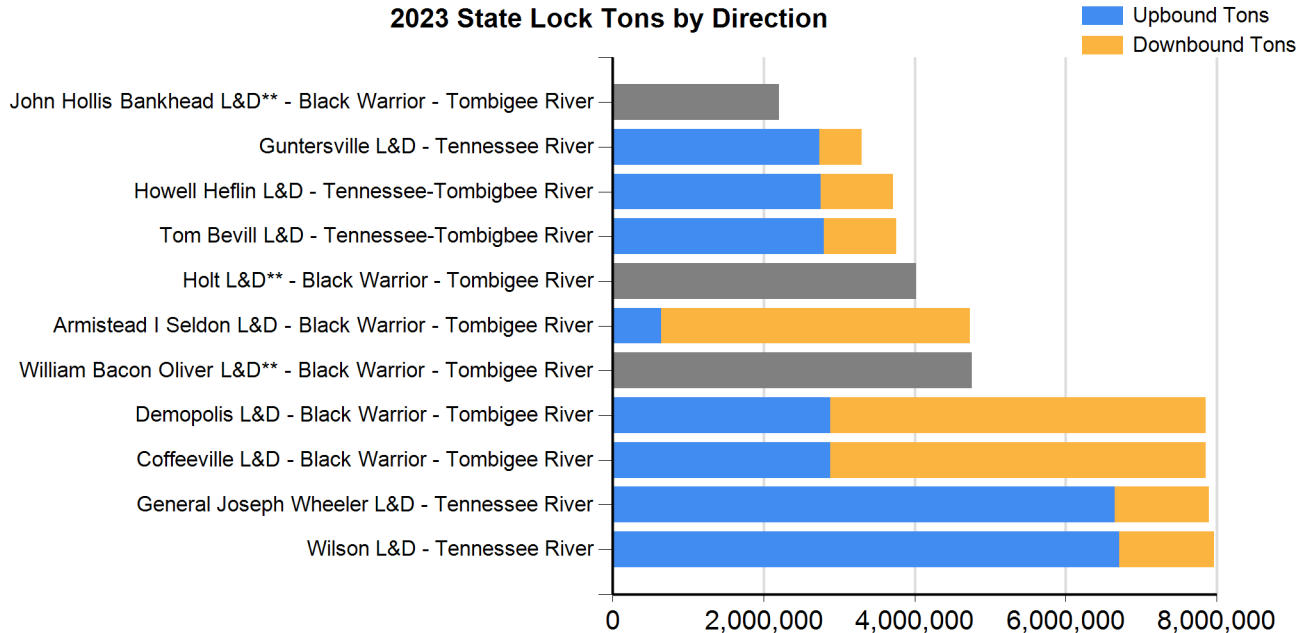

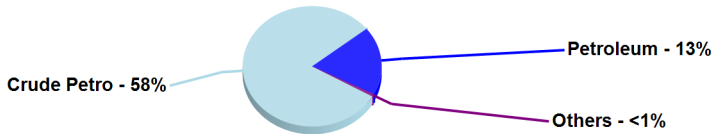

2023 Coastal Traffic Commodity Value Distribution

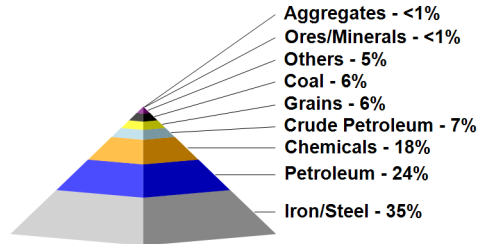
