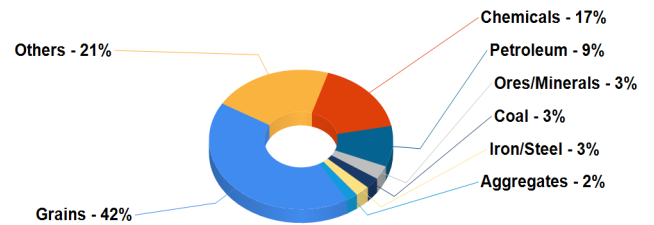

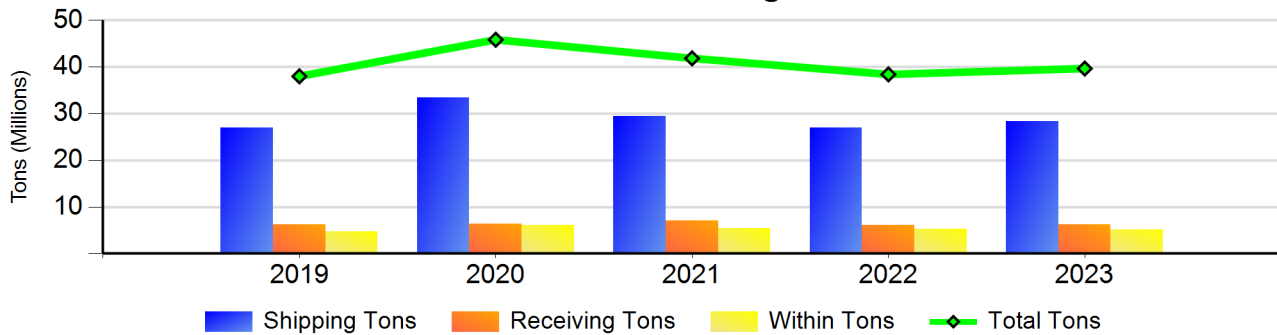
### 2023 All Traffic Commodity Value Distribution

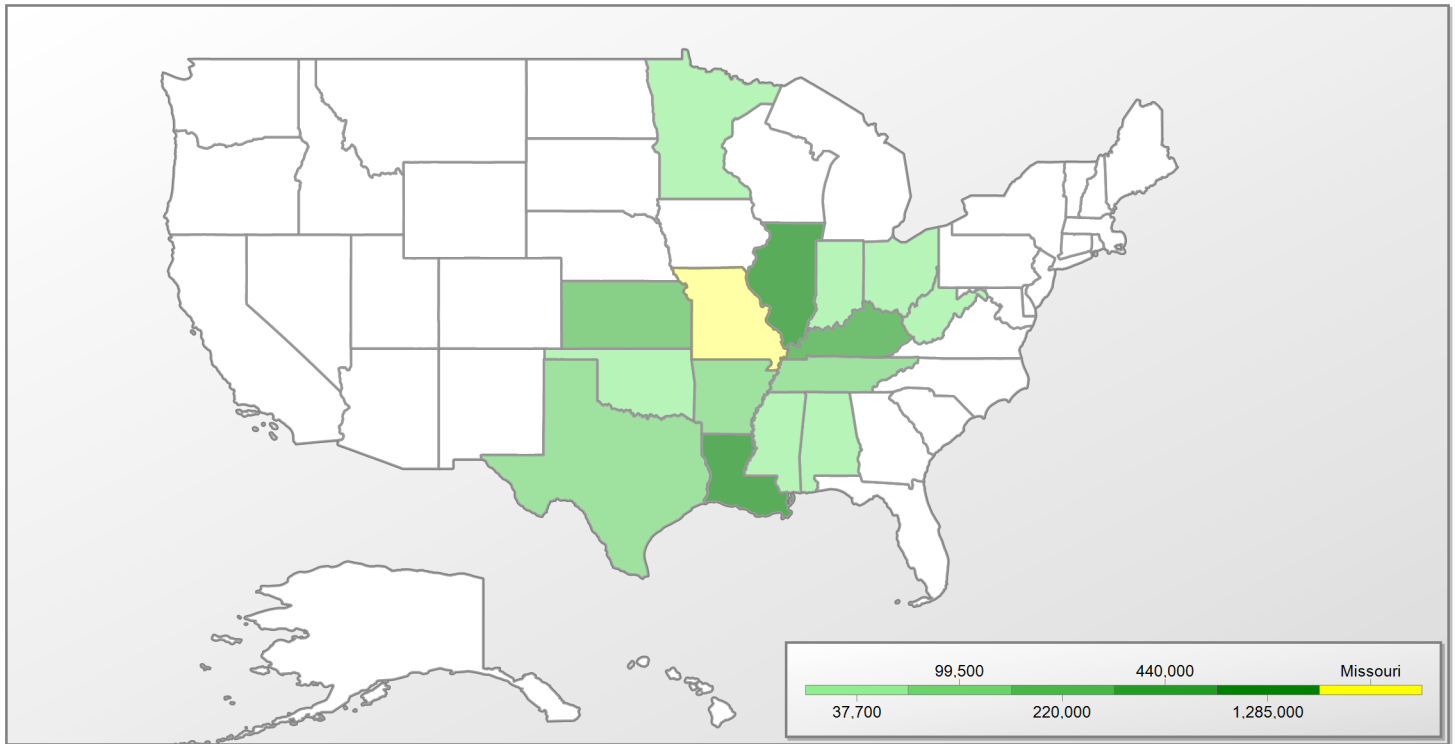

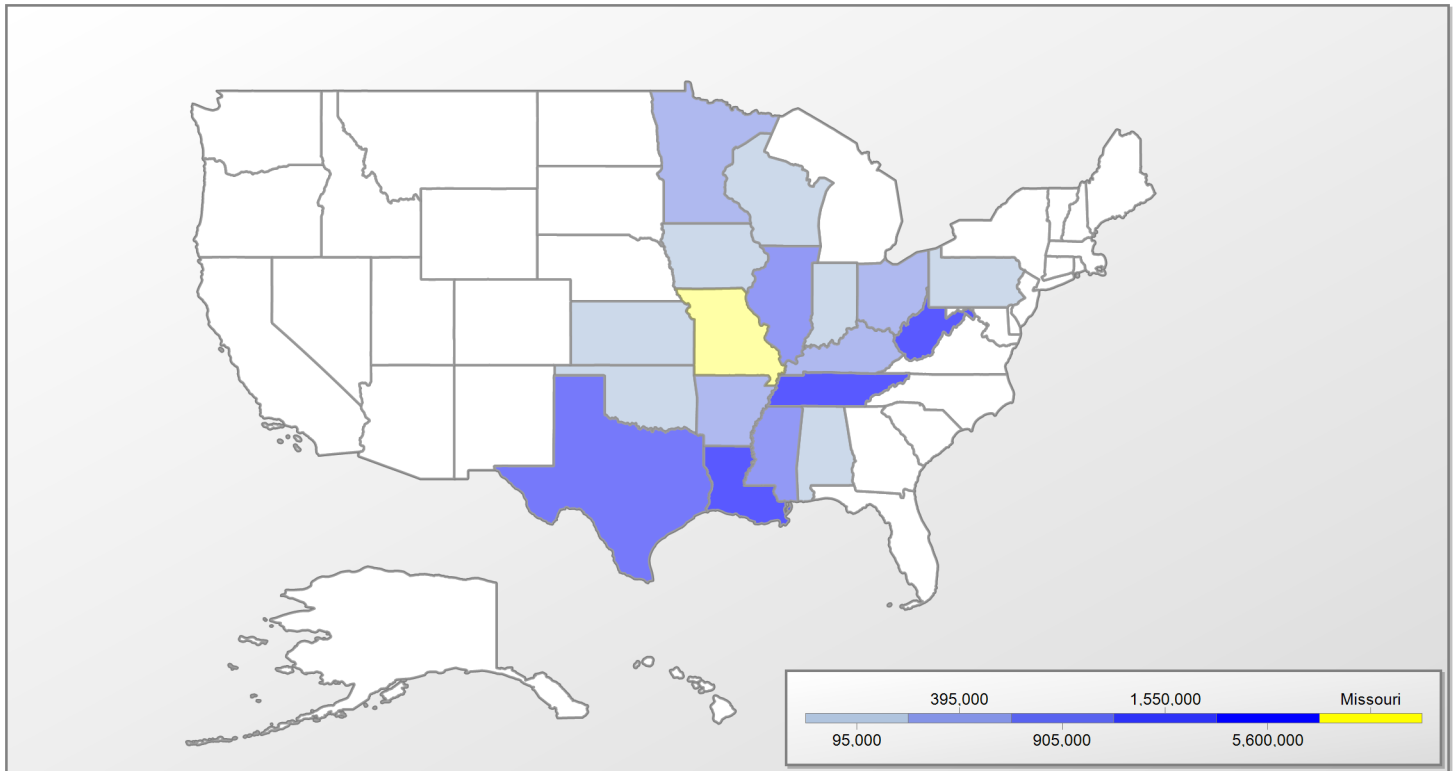

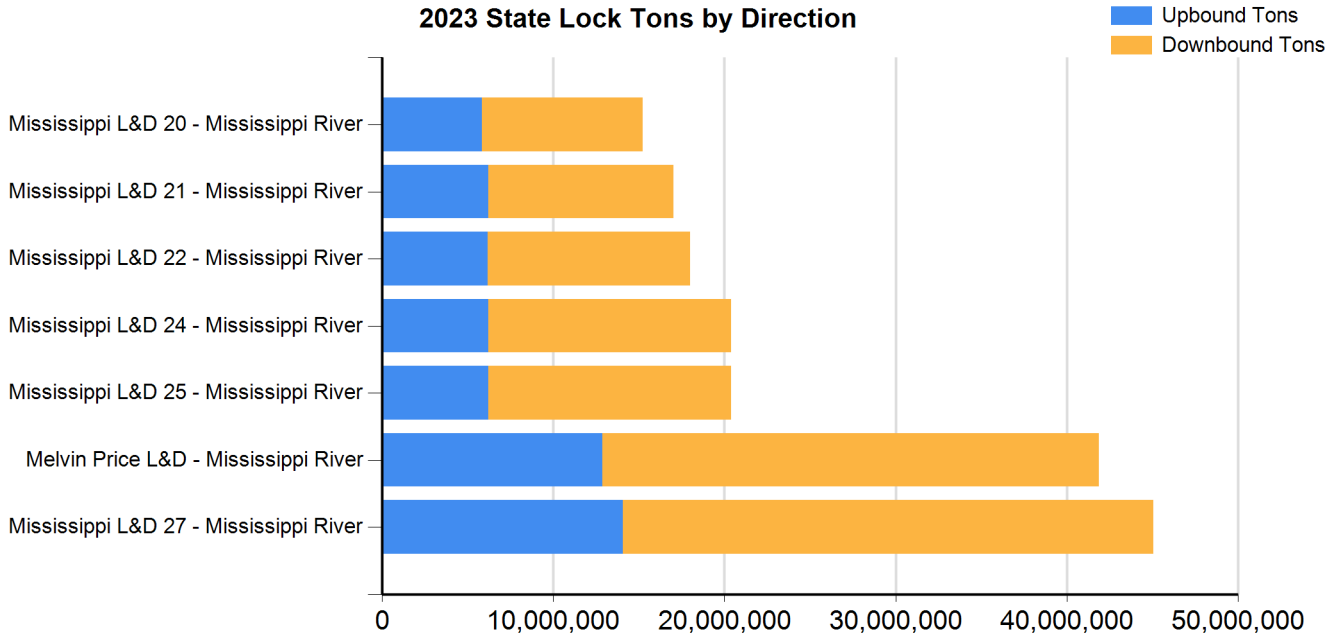

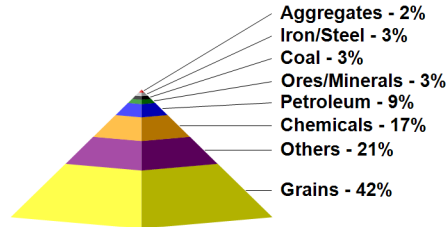
