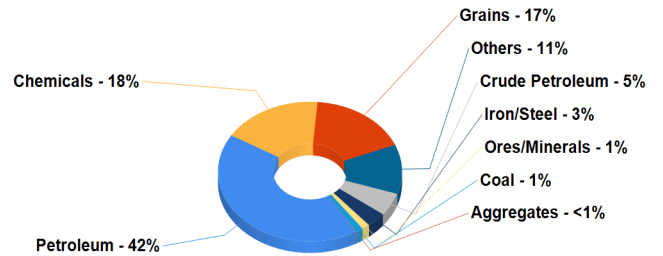

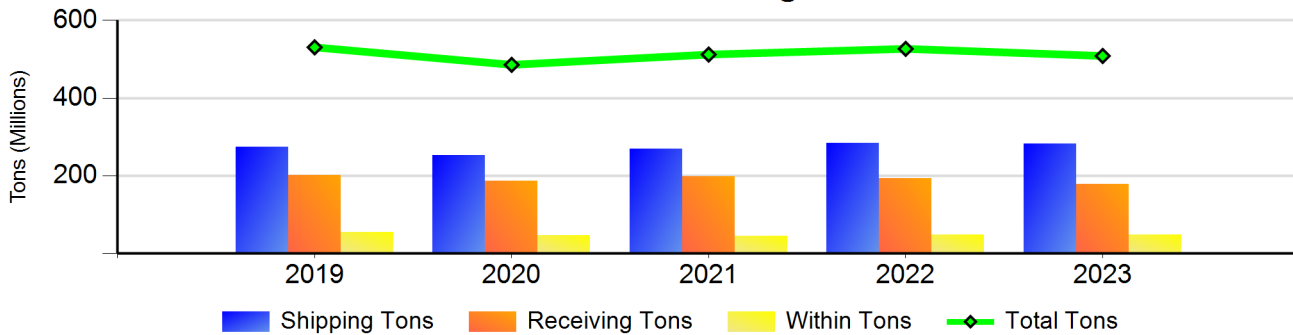

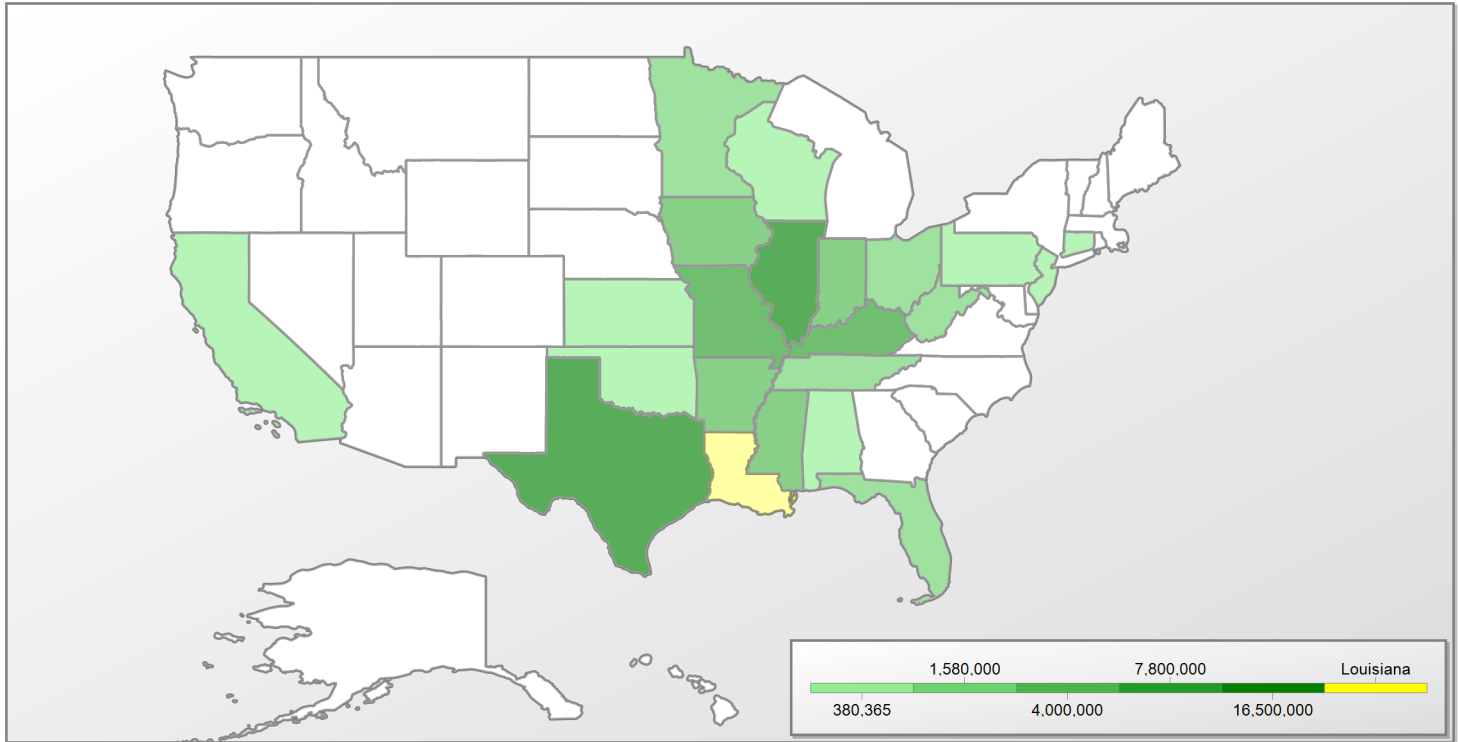

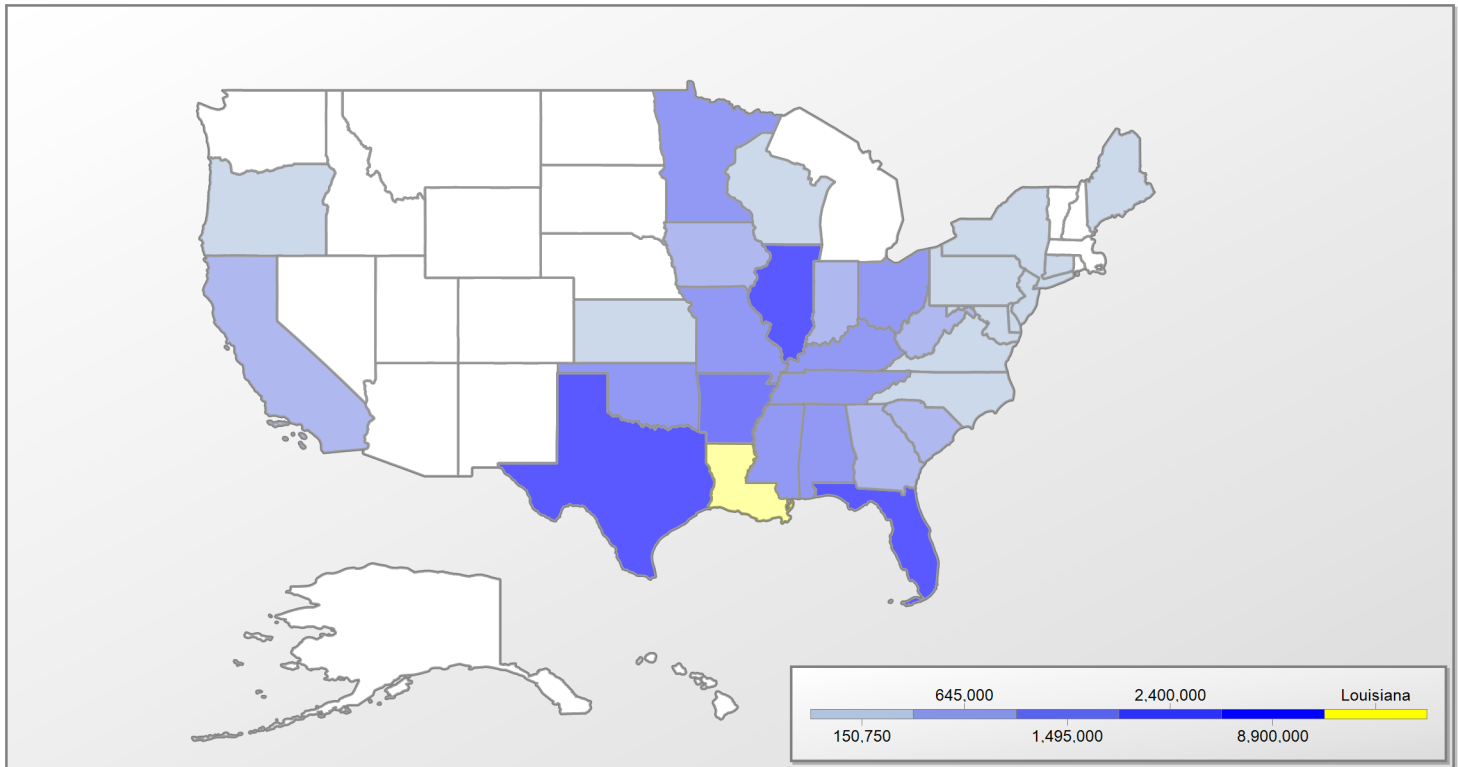

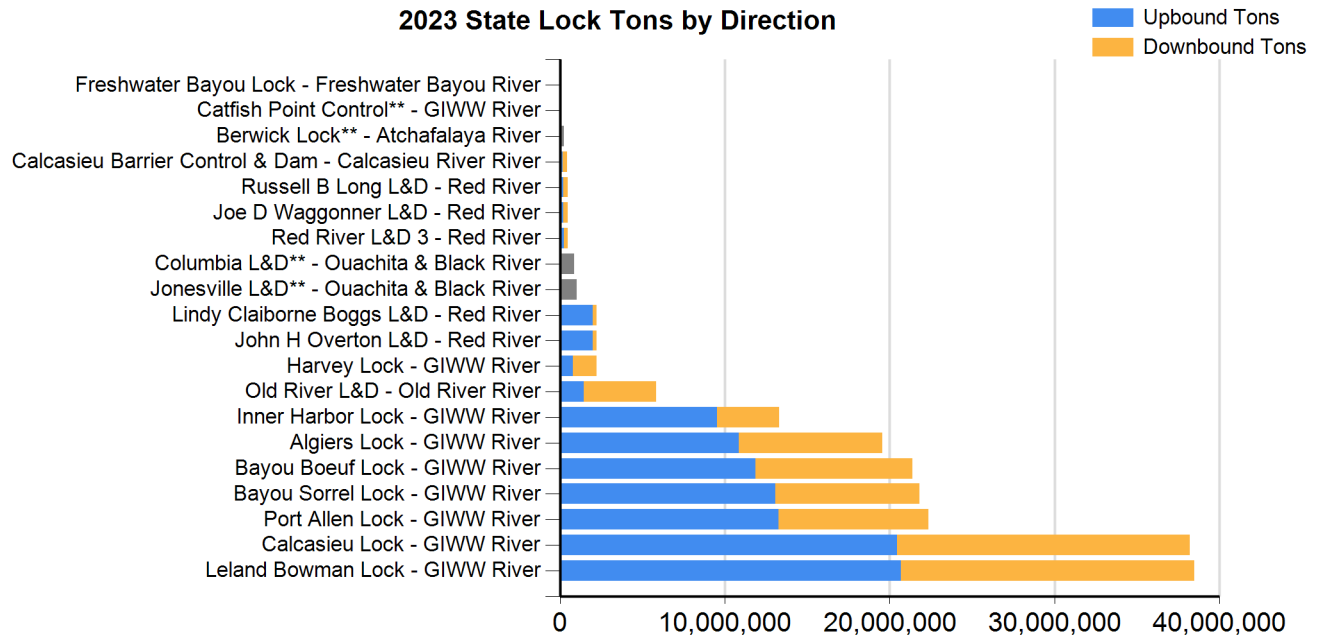

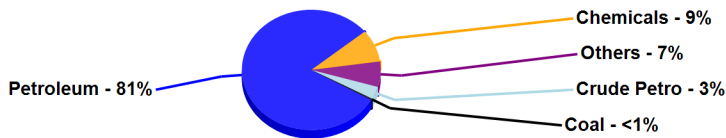

2023 Coastal Traffic Commodity Value Distribution

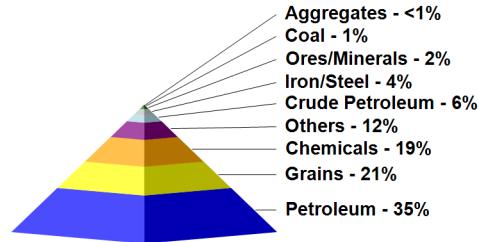
