

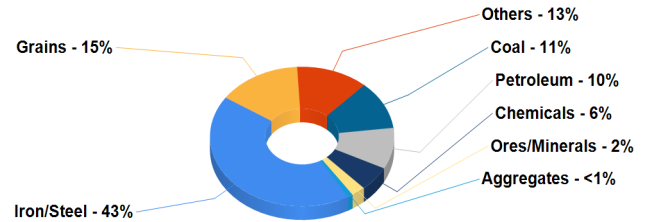

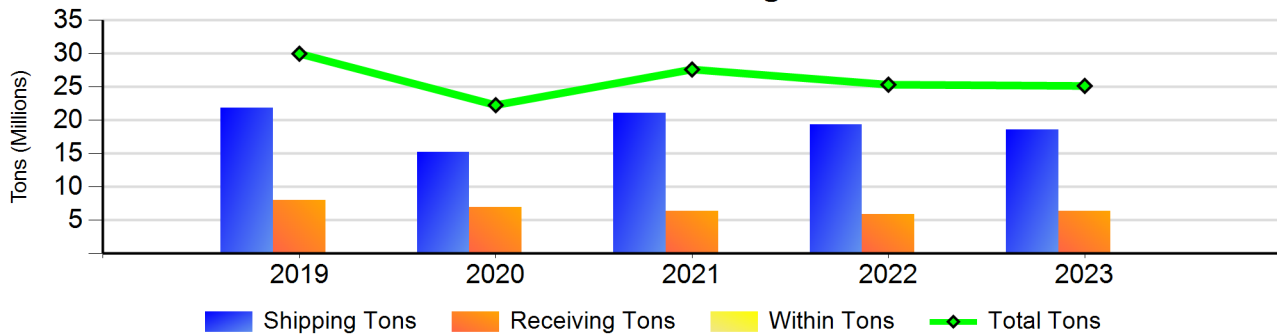

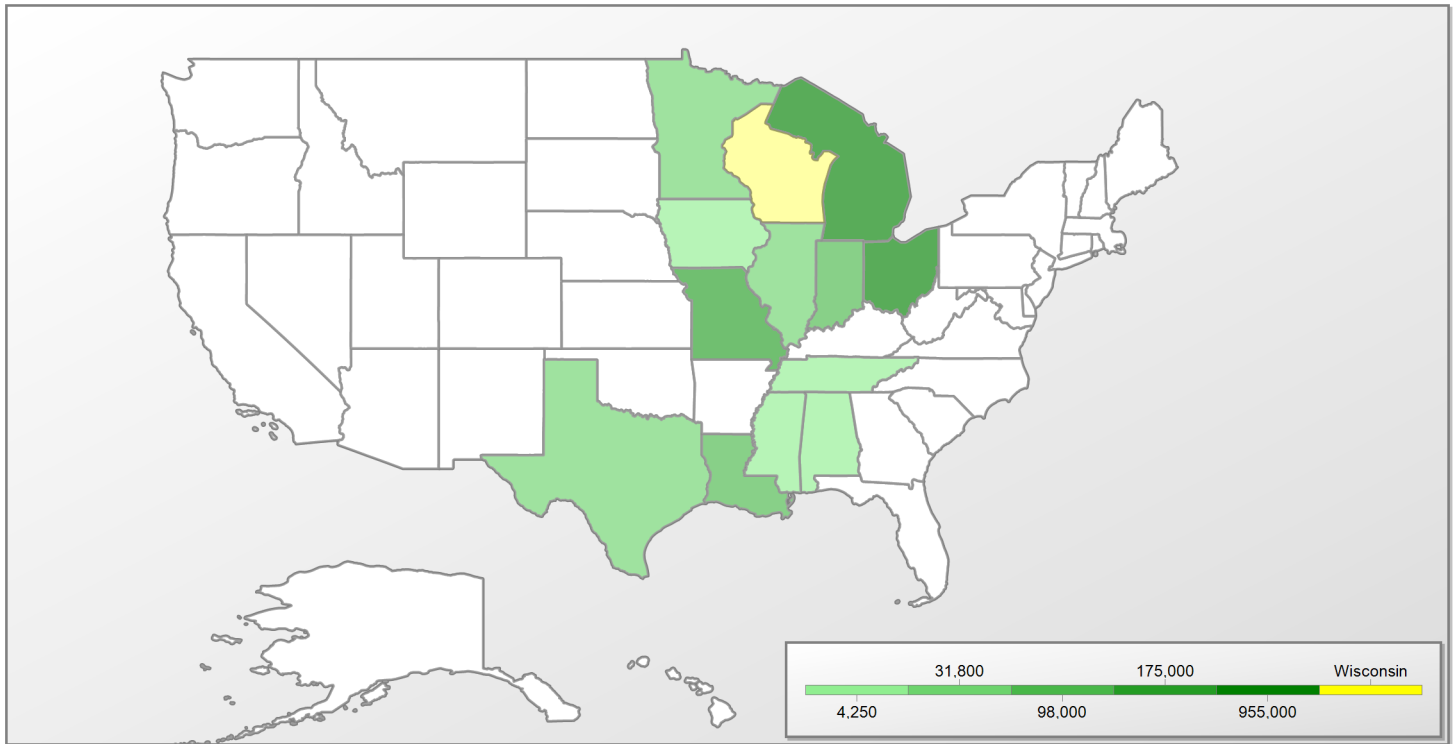

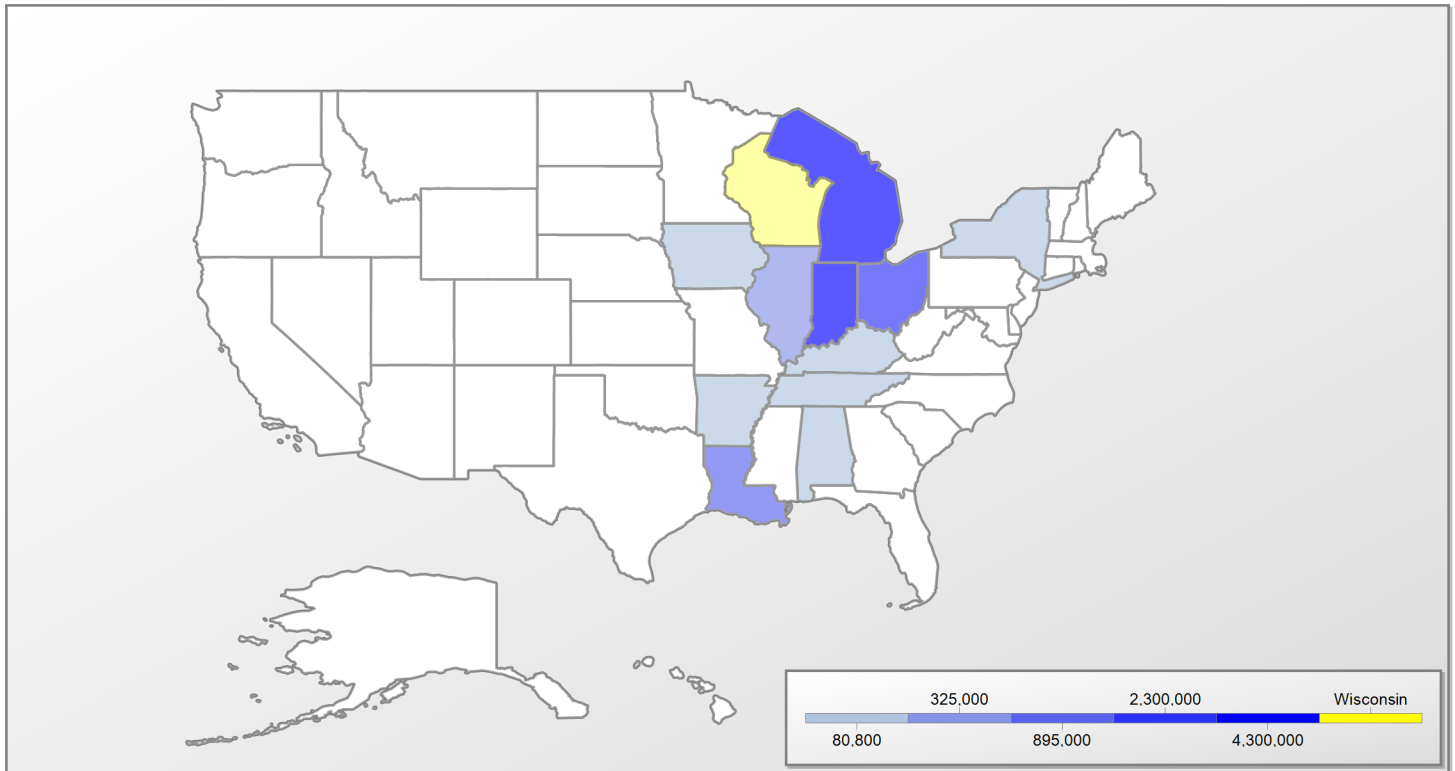

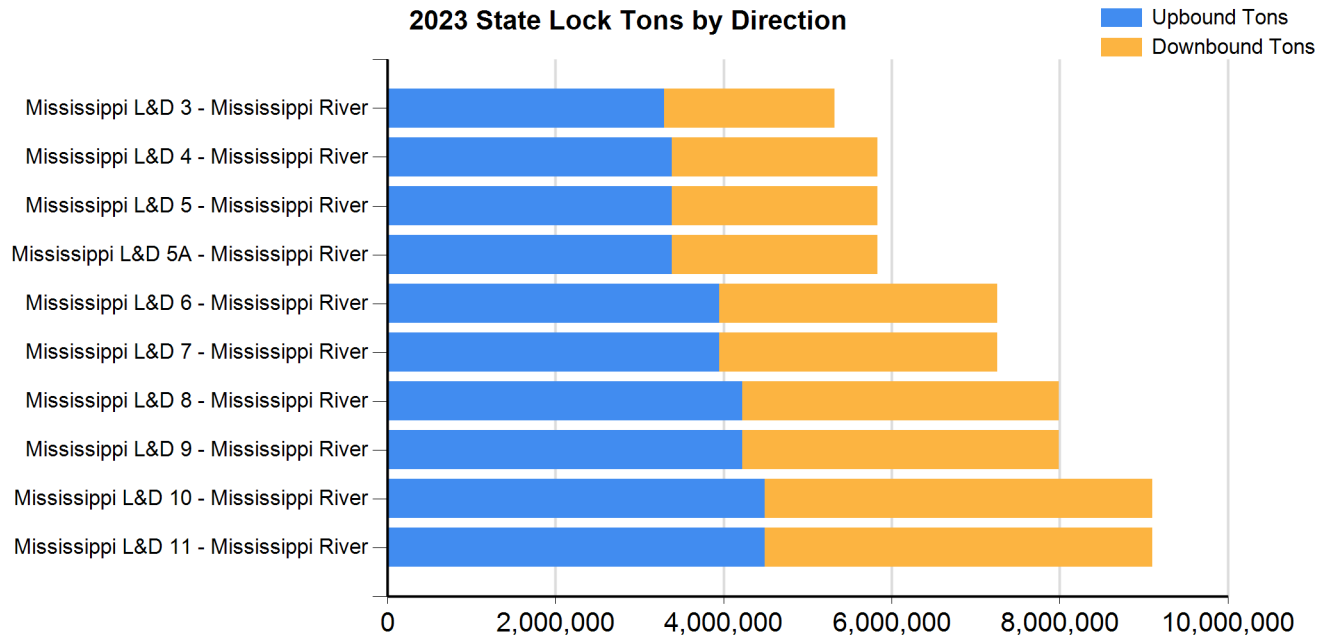

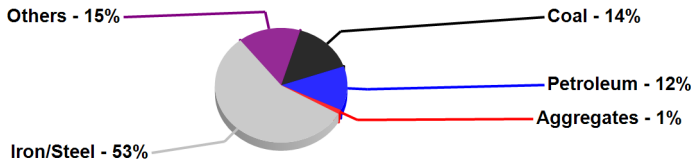

2023 Great Lakes Traffic Commodity Value Distribution

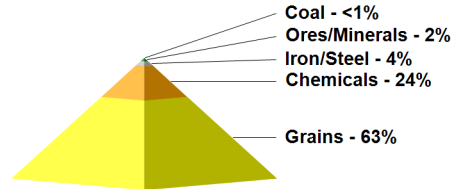
